Statement from the Board of Elections in the City of New York

The Board of Elections in the City of New York has successfully met the deadline for mailing all Military and Special Federal Absentee Ballots in preparation for the upcoming 2011 Elections. According to State Election Law, the Board was required to mail voting information by July 29, 2011 to those New York City voters who indicated a preference to receive their information by mail. The Board deployed all requested mailings by July 28, 2011, one day ahead of the requirement.

Ensuring all New York City voters, including Military and Special Federal voters, are afforded the right to participate in the electoral process is a top priority for the Board of Elections. In order to provide absentee ballots to those unable to vote in person on Election Day, various departments within the Board worked together to ensure the deadline was met and for their dedication, the Commissioners of the Board offers its sincere gratitude.
