DEMONSTRATIONS AND A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED VOTING SYSTEMS TO BE USED IN NEW YORK CITY FOR THE 2007 ELECTIONS AND BEYOND

PUBLIC DEMONSTRATIONS:

The Board of Elections (BOE) in the City of New York has requested that all voting system vendors applying for certification in New York State conduct two public demonstrations of their voting systems. The systems are listed below:

- 1) **Avante:** VOTE-TRAKKER™ EVC308-FF (Touch Screen DRE)
- 2) **ES&S:** Model 100 (Optical Scan) and ES&S AutoMARK (Ballot Marking Device)
- 3) **Diebold:** AccuVote-OS (Optical Scan) and AutoMARK VAT (Ballot Marking Device)
- 4) **Sequoia:** AVC Advantage Plus (Touch Screen DRE)
- 5) **Sequoia:** Optech Insight (Optical Scan)

Each vendor will provide two systems for the demonstration. One system will be in the auditorium and used for a formal presentation to the public. Another system will be set up in the atrium and will be available for public trial.

Each vendor will conduct a half hour presentation followed by audience questions & answers. The demonstrations will be conducted from 5-9 PM on Jan. 4th, 11th and 22nd. The locations are as follows:

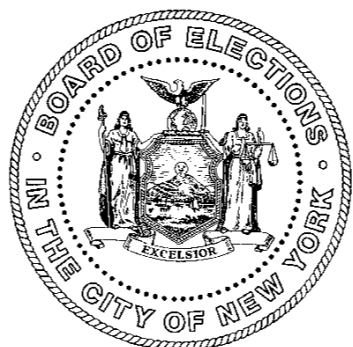
PUBLIC HEARING:
