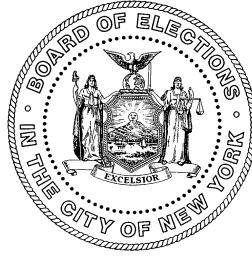

STATEMENT OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF ELECTIONS IN THE CITY OF NEW YORK WITH RESPECT TO DOCUMENTS FILED RELATING TO THE SEPTEMBER 2007 PRIMARY ELECTION PRIOR TO THE ENACTMENT OF CHAPTER 49 OF THE LAWS OF 2007

The Commissioners of Elections in the City of New York, at their public meeting held on Tuesday, May 29, 2007 unanimously adopted the following statement with respect to documents filed with this Board relating to the September 2007 Primary Election, prior to the enactment of Chapter 49 of the Laws of 2007 (on May 30, 2007) which changed the date of the 2007 Primary Election from September 11, 2007 to September 18, 2007:

As a consequence of the enactment of Chapter 49 of the Laws of 2007, which changes the date of the September 2007 Primary Election from September 11 to September 18, all documents filed with the Board of Elections in the City of New York prior to the date of enactment of Chapter 49 of the Laws of 2007, which refers to the September 11, 2007 Primary Election are now deemed to refer to the September 18, 2007 Primary Election.
